
Regional Minister's Message

20th OFS Quinquennial Congress 2021: JUBILEE! August 2021

Secular Franciscans will celebrate the 800th anniversary of the approval of our 1221 Rule.

What is a Quinquennial? The dictionary defines it as an event that happens every five years. In our Franciscan history, we recall that Francis would gather the members of the Order for a chapter of mats – where the members of the Order would take up their mats and meet for the purpose of prayer, formation, sharing and jubilation. We continue that tradition. Every five years, members of our National Family gather for the same purpose. Our documents call this a "National Congress," and this gathering has come to be known as the "Quinquennial," or "Q" for short. Of course, today, we are far more comfortable – we don't have to sleep on mats – but our intention is the same. *More info to come*.
